



PIIFA Invitational Ice Fishing Derby Rules

Petrie Island, Orleans, Ontario, Canada

1. The derby is scheduled for Saturday, February 17, 2018 from 10:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. on Baitshop Bay, Petrie Island, Orleans, Ontario.
2. All participants must register and pay before the derby begins.
3. A horn will sound at 10:00 A.M. to indicate the official start time. A horn will sound at 4:00 P.M. to indicate the official stop time.
4. All participants must have their registration card with them at all times during the derby.
5. Participants must fish in the area of Baitshop Bay which is the designated area for the derby.
6. Ontario fishing regulations are in effect and must be observed.
7. Participants may fish a maximum of 2 lines.
8. Only legal and in-season fish will be considered for a prize.
9. Any fish that cannot be released alive will not be weighed.
10. Participants may not pass fish from one ticket/contestant to another ticket/contestant. If caught, fish and/or participant will be disqualified and no prize will be awarded. Please report any such incidents to the organizer.
11. All fish to be registered must be brought to the weigh-in area near Big Al's hut as soon as possible and must be alive. Please have a container available for your fish as this is a catch and release event.
12. All fish must be weighed prior to 4:00 P.M. No late fish will be accepted or weighed.
13. Failure to comply with the contest rules subjects the participant to disqualification.
14. Prizes will be awarded as soon as possible after the event ends.
15. All participants must do their utmost to exhibit good sportsmanship.
16. By entering the derby all participants declare an understanding of all derby rules and agree to abide by them.
17. The organizer may at any time before, during and after the event change the event format if so required.

This is an invitational event organized exclusively for the hut owners of Petrie Island, their invited guests and the hut renters of the Oziles' Marina and Bait Shop. This event is coordinated with Ontario's Family Fishing Week-end and Ontario Outdoors cards and fishing permits are not required to participate.
